The AVODAH year is designed as an all-inclusive program where every major cost is already accounted for. From housing and meals to mission travel and training, the programme fee ensures that participants can focus fully on spiritual growth, leadership development, and outreach without worrying about hidden expenses.

Our financial structure is transparent: each cost is carefully budgeted, and payment options are flexible to support families. The breakdown below shows exactly why we ask what we ask — every rand is tied to a tangible part of the journey.

Sponsored Budget Items

33% of the **total** budget is already covered through sponsorships and partnerships, reducing the direct cost to each student.

Terms & Conditions – Payment Compliance

- To ensure fairness and sustainability of the AVODAH programme, all students must keep their fees up to date according to the published payment schedule.
- Students whose payments are not current will not be permitted to join any outreach trips, mission travel, or special programme activities until outstanding balances are settled.
- If a student falls four months behind on payments, they will be required to leave the programme and return home at their own cost

Consequences & Support

- We understand that financial challenges can arise. Families are encouraged to:
- Communicate promptly with the AVODAH office if difficulties occur.
- Explore possible solutions or support options before deadlines are missed.
- By enrolling, each student and their family acknowledges and accepts these conditions as part of the financial agreement with AVODAH.

This policy protects the integrity of the programme budget and ensures that resources are available for those who remain committed.

Payment Options

We understand that every family's financial situation is different, which is why AVODAH offers two flexible payment options.

Monthly Plan

- Admission Fee: R13,300 Must be paid before 10 January 2027.
- Monthly Fee: R13,300 Due on the last day of each month from February to October 2027.

Once-Off Plan

- Admission Fee: R13,300 must be paid before 10 January 2027.
- Annual Fee (before 31 January 2027): R113,050
- Additional 5% discount applied for once-off payment.

Total: R126 350

Exclusions

JANUARY - NOVEMBER

The programme fee does not cover:

- Medical & travel insurance
- Laptops (no tablets)
- Personal electronics beyond programme use
- Pocket money & snacks
- Bedding & accessories
- Toiletries & hygiene products
- Travel gear for outreaches (see packing list)

Accommodation & Meals

- Students are provided with a comfortable home base and daily meals, creating a stable environment where they can focus on growing in their faith, building friendships, and developing leadership skills without having to worry about the essentials.

Transport & Programme Operations

- From getting to outreach locations to travelling between training events and activities, transport and programme logistics are covered. This helps everything run smoothly and allows students to focus on making the most of the journey.

Mission Travel

- International mission trips are fully organised and funded. These experiences give students the opportunity to step out of their comfort zones, serve communities, share the gospel, and experience different cultures in a meaningful and life-changing way.

Training, Mentorship & Wellbeing

- AVODAH invests heavily in each student's growth through biblical teaching, practical training, leadership development, mentorship, and wellness support. The goal is not only to equip students for the year ahead, but to help them build a strong foundation for a lifetime of impact.

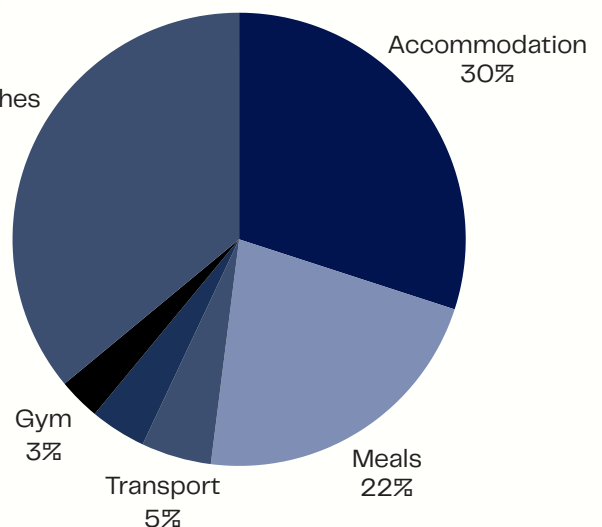
